Faithful Findings

I'm going to be real with you, last month was really challenging for me. Every week had a new hurdle to stumble over or a curveball thrown my way that really knocked me down. We are already in June, and I feel like I've experienced a rollercoaster's worth of highs and lows this year to make anybody nauseous. Maybe you've felt that way too. Life has a way of exhausting us when we least expect it. In seasons like these, I want to focus on the joy that can be found in them. There are brighter days ahead, especially since we are entering the beginning of Summer!

As Bryan and I have been preaching our way through the book of Hebrews, we have finally arrived at the most memorable chapter. Chapter 11 begins by defining what faith is. "Now faith is confidence in what we hope for and assurance about what we do not see." (NIV) The author tells story after story of ordinary people who trusted God when they could not see the outcome. Their faith carried them through fear, uncertainty, loss, and struggles, and continues to inspire us to this day.

Faith is often most visible when life feels the hardest. It's choosing prayer instead of panic. It's continuing to worship after a painful week. It's trusting God when the answers haven't come and the future feels unclear. Anyone can say they have faith when life is easy, but real faith holds on when everything around us feels shaky.

Jesus said, "Truly I tell you, if you have faith as small as a mustard seed, you can say to this mountain, 'Move from here to there,' and it will move. Nothing will be impossible for you." (Matthew 17:20, NIV) That means even small faith matters. We don't have to pretend we are strong all the time or hide the struggles we carry. Faith is simply believing that God is still working, even when we cannot yet see it.

Let's commit ourselves to living by faith again. Trust in God. Pray boldly. Be encouraging. Invite someone to church. Hold onto hope. The world doesn't need perfect people with perfect lives. It needs people willing to trust a perfect Savior through both the highs and the lows. See what God can do through one simple act of faith.
