Another objective of ACT is to come alongside of and help people understand their responsibilities towards their families and their society. Through various community development programs, participants are able to become more self-sufficient and meet their own daily needs. One of these methods is the adult literacy programs, which are used to teach people about Jesus and to give them the ability to read the Word of God. Over 6,500 previously-illiterate adults have come to Christ this way.
